

Policy Directive

Use of Clubhouses - Minors

Children of community members who are between the ages of thirteen and eighteen will be allowed to sponsor one (1) non-member "guest" into a clubhouse at any time... said guest to be signed in at the clubhouse when the member enters the clubhouse and signed out when the member leaves the clubhouse. Furthermore, since the member parent will have financial responsibility for damage that may be caused by their child(ren) or guest, parents / members will be asked to provide the community with a list of guests heir child(ren) are permitted to sign into the clubhouse... thus enabling parents to have more supervision over who is allowed into community facilities under the auspices of their membership.

The community will continue to restrict access to the clubhouse to all children under 13. These children will not be allowed into the clubhouse without adult supervision provided by a community member at all times during the visit to the facility.
