

Public Works Report May 2020

Spring Cleanup: Once again our crew is hard at work removing the organic debris that has accumulated on the landscape of our facilities. That list includes 2 clubhouses, 2 playgrounds, 5 tennis courts, 3 basketball courts and 14 beach/picnic areas. It takes several weeks to get all that taken care of.



Transmission Main Update: Nothing much to report on this. Due to being short staffed and other time sensitive priorities this project is on hold while the crew takes care of other missions. We will get back to it soon.

Swimming Pools: Today we uncovered the outdoor pool at Club 2 and are bringing all three pools back on line in preparation for opening at the end of the month.

Picnic Tables: On very rainy days our crew has been refurbishing quite a few of our older picnic tables that needed new boards, sanding and stain. In addition we purchased a couple new tables for the outside pool area at Clubhouse 2.

Main Breaks: Only one water main break to report. That break was located on Redwood Circle.

Equipment Repair/Inspection: Because we have an extensive fleet of trucks and equipment there is rarely a dull moment in our shop. Our new mechanic Tyler is very busy purchasing and installing parts to keep our fleet operating and safe. This past month he has been replacing major suspension parts on several of the dump trucks.
